



Dear media representatives,

welcome to the 30th FIS Ski Jumping World Cup in Willingen. This year, the ski club is celebrating not only the anniversary of this international sporting event, but also the 100th anniversary of the Mühlenkopfschanze ski jump. At the premiere in 1926, the longest jump was 34 metres. Today, after multiple renovations to create a modern large hill, the hill record stands at 155.5 metres, held by Norwegian Johann Andre Forfang (2024).

Since 1995, the Willingen Ski Club has hosted the World Cup ski jumping event every year, with two interruptions. The women have been competing at Mühlenkopf since 2022. This year, there are five events on the programme: a mixed team competition on Friday and two individual jumps for women and men on Saturday and Sunday.

To help you report on the competitions without any problems, the press team will be on hand from Thursday to Sunday to offer advice and assistance in the press centre, the sub-press centre or the mixed zone. If you have any questions or requests, please do not hesitate to contact us!

Results lists will be sent via WhatsApp and printed only on request, while start lists will be available in printed form so that you can have a good overview during the competitions.

Photographers will be provided with a photo shirt. This will be issued at the press centre for a deposit of 30 euros and must be worn at the ski jump. The deposit will be refunded when the shirt is returned to the press centre.

Wi-Fi access is available at the reception desk in the press centre. You can use it free of charge. The account is valid for the entire weekend in the press and sub-press centre (until midnight on 1 February).

A shuttle service, which is available until the evening hours, runs every day between the press centre and the stop at the Mühlenkopfschanze (100 metres from the function building). In addition, a shuttle bus service between the stadium and the inrun tower is available for photographers and journalists before and during the competition.
